**What does deliberate, thorough and responsible decommissioning mean?
What does deliberate, thorough and responsible decommissioning look like?**

Vermont does not have any legal say over the decommissioning process. The Safe Power Vermont Coalition is asking the PSB to offer Certificate of Public Good with conditions that stipulate Entergy:

- use union labor for all decommissioning work as workplace safety standards, quality control, and worker training are better served by employing union labor.
- empty the spent fuel pool on the most expeditious timeline possible. When all the fuel is sufficiently cooled it must be transferred to dry casks.
- only be allowed to operate using a closed-loop cooling cycle. Thermal pollution of the Connecticut River must end.
