No More Pork for FirstEnergy Solutions!

Giant inflatable pig will remind Medina residents that FES wants to break the bank

MEDINA, OH – Join Medina-area residents and leaders from Ohio’s largest consumer and advocacy communities as they gather in Medina Public Square in opposition to legislative efforts at the Statehouse to impose a consumer-funded bailout of two FirstEnergy Solutions nuclear plants and two of the area’s dirtiest coal plants. House Bill 6 also repeals the state’s effective renewable energy and efficiency programs, potentially making Ohio the first state in the nation to consider gutting clean energy standards to fund coal and nuclear bailouts. The State Senate is currently hearing the legislation under the guidance of Senate President Larry Obhof of Medina.

The event will be hosted in the shadow of a giant inflatable pig, reminding area residents that FirstEnergy Solutions wants to bring home the bacon at the expense of all Ohio consumers.
