Excerpts from WCAX and WPTZ interviews with Curt Hebert; Entergy's new point man in Vermont who has replaced Jay Thayer:

Kristin Carlson: You've lost the support of the governor at this point, I would say almost every state leader, you have New Hampshire and Massachusetts leaders also concerned. Given all of that, will the company say enough is enough; we don't want to be here anymore?
